

Temporary guidelines for sightseeing in Stutthof Museum in Sztutowo

- 1) The museum is open for visitors: from Tuesday to Sunday, between 9: 00 am and 5: 00 p.m.
On Mondays between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm. Last entrance to the Museum at 4:30 p.m.
- 2) Museum exhibitions, outdoor area, Visitors Service Office, parking toilet are available for visitors
- 3) In Visitors Service Office a maximum of 2 persons may be present at one moment, except Museum's staff.
- 4) Indoors, in the Visitors Service Office and at the exhibitions it is obligatory to cover the mouth and nose.
- 5) The museum cinema is closed.
- 6) Visitors of the Museum are obligated to follow sanitary rigors, as in public places it is mandatory to:
 - a. keep an appropriate distance;
 - b. decontaminate hands before entering the the Museum and Visitors Service Office.
- 7) Security Guard or an employee of the Visitors Office may temporarily withhold the entry into the Museum and museum exhibitions when the density of visitors precludes maintaining safe distance between them.
- 8) It is possible to use a paid service of a Guided Tour in groups of up to 10 persons- information available at the Visitors Service Office.
- 9) No litter can be left at the premises of Museum. A bin to segregate them is located near the entrance.
- 10) Museum car park is paid.
- 11) Temporary guidelines for sightseeing specified in the paragraphs above shall be valid until further notice, regardless of the regulations of sightseeing in the Museum currently in force, established by directive 31/2017 of 24th November 2017.
